Located in the historic Anacostia neighborhood of Washington, D.C., offers a vibrant and immersive experience into the rich legacy of Go-Go music. In 2019, the Mayor of the District of Columbia officially recognized Go-Go as the city's official music, marking a pivotal moment in cultural preservation.

The museum began as a virtual initiative in 2020 and proudly opened its physical doors in 2025. Its mission is to educate the public, celebrate the genre, and serve as a cultural hub for the Go-Go community. Since its inception, the museum has fostered a dynamic and inclusive environment, bringing together diverse elements to strengthen and unify the community.

Visitors are taken on a compelling journey through the origins of Go-Go, spotlighting the legendary Chuck Brown—widely known as the Godfather of Go-Go—and his groundbreaking fusion of funk and hip-hop. The museum features interactive digital exhibits that delve into the genre's history, musical samples, and its influence on other music styles and popular films. The tour concludes with a live Go-Go conga demonstration, offering a hands-on glimpse into the rhythm that defines the genre.

A visit to the Go-Go Museum & Café is a powerful way to explore how African American communities and their allies have come together to preserve and advance Go-Go music, while also creating new opportunities for cultural expression and growth.
