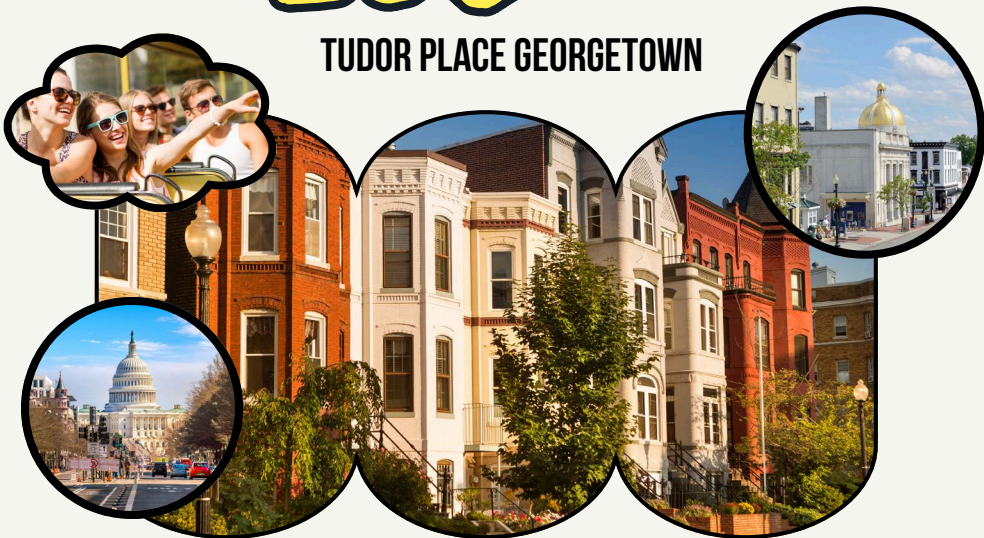

THE TUDOR PLACE EXPERIENCE IN *Georgetown* WASHINGTON , DC

Nestled in the heart of picturesque Georgetown, Tudor Place is a stunning Federal-style mansion that preserves the legacy of six generations descended from Martha Washington. Originally built as the home of Thomas Peter and his wife, Martha Parke Custis Peter—Martha Washington's granddaughter—the estate offers a unique glimpse into American history.

Set on 5.5 acres of beautifully landscaped grounds, Tudor Place is surrounded by manicured lawns and charming, hilly streets. During your tour, you'll explore the mansion's lower level, including elegant hallways, art-filled living and dining rooms, historic office spaces, a vintage kitchen, and an impressive porcelain collection. The home features over 18,000 decorative objects, including the largest Washington Collection outside of Mount Vernon.

As you walk through the rooms, you'll learn about the lives of those who lived and visited here, including the enslaved individuals who labored on the property. Once a venue for elite social gatherings, Tudor Place is now a National Historic Landmark dedicated to preserving the stories of all who shaped its history. It continues to host public and private events, offering a meaningful connection to America's past.
