Set on the Virginia Peninsula and forming part of the Historic Triangle alongside Yorktown and Jamestown, Williamsburg, VA is a charming city steeped in Revolutionary history. As the site of the nation's largest living history museum, Colonial Williamsburg is the perfect place for historic immersion.

Explore some of the most captivating exhibits, including hands-on demonstrations at colonial workshops along with your private guide. Think trades such as the apothecary, blacksmith, gunsmith, silversmith, bookbinder, brickmaker, carpenter, farmer, gardener, shoemaker, and many more. You'll also visit authentic colonial homes and the stately Governor's Palace, where you'll learn about the life of Virginia's governor and those who served him.

Another highlight is the Capitol building, where you'll gain insight into the workings of colonial government. While your guide will introduce you to many of the key sites and stories, there will be plenty of time left for you to explore the grounds and attractions at your own pace.

EXPERT ADVICE:

A visit to Colonial Williamsburg is recommended to a full day (6-8 hours). There are plenty of dining options on site available. Should guests however prefer a shorter visit. Colonial Williamsburg can be paired with either Yorktown and/or Jamestown.
